August 26, 2022

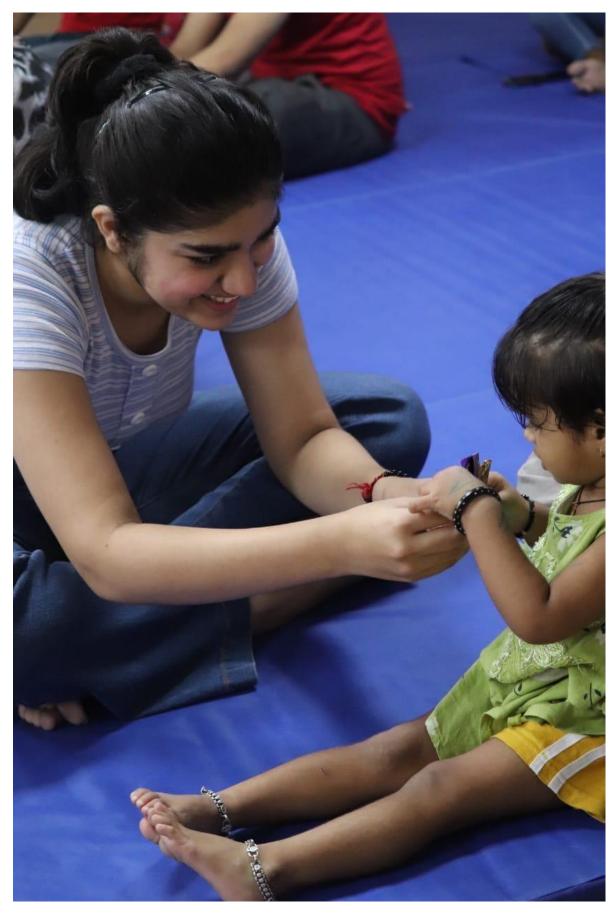
IAMD Visit by Shoolini Volunteers

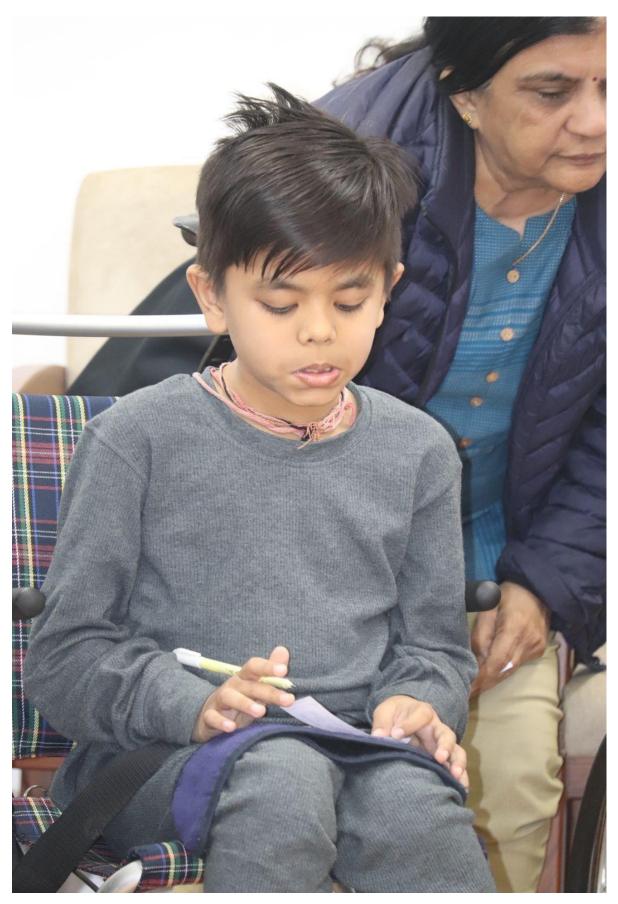
