Addendum Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made and entered into at Shoulin University on this July 21, 2017 ("Effective Date") by and between

Cambridge Energy Resources Pvt. Ltd., a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at1166 and 1167, 11th Floor, Tower B 1, Spaze I, Tech Park, Sector 49, Sohna Road, Gurgaon, Haryana -122018(hereinafter referred to as the "CERPL" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the FIRST PART;

AND

Foundation for life sciences and business management, having its registered office at Anand Complex Near Head Post Office, The Mall Dist Solan-173212 (hereinafter referred to as the "FLSBM" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning hereof, include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PART.

CERPL and FLSBM are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS

A. The present MOU (Hereinafter refereed as MOU) between CERPL and FLSBM is in addition to the terms and conditions agreed by the parties though Power purchase agreement signed by the parties on 12th May 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto as under:

1. SCOPE AND OBJECTIVE

1.1 **CERPL** agrees to install and operate a solar photovoltaic power plant of **400 KWP** capacity and **FLSBM** agrees to purchase the entire solar power of the project after completion of seven years.

2. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT TERMS

- 2.1 Advance fee of Rs. 5,17,500/- (Inclusive of taxes) will be given by FLSBM in favour of CERPL which will be adjusted from the receivables from FLSBM overtime.
- 2.2 Plant will be moved to **FLSBM** at the end of seven years and the final residual value to be paid by FLSBM at the end of 7 years be 150 lacs.
- 2.3 The PPA Rate will be @3/-.

- 2.2 Plant will be moved to **FLSBM** at the end of seven years and the final residual value to be paid by FLSBM at the end of 7 years be 150 lacs.
- 2.3 The PPA Rate will be @3/-.
- 2.4 As a goodwill gesture CERPL will provide FLSBM with value addition to the extent of Rs. 3500 per/k/Wp in the form of street light, E car, DG etc. This is subject to the realization of total subsidy by CERPL.
- 2.5 For the period when generation is more than the usage, the extra energy will feed into the grid and for that CERPL charge from FLSBM the tariff at the prevalant feed in tariff rate of the state DISCOM.
